## MATCH REPORTS

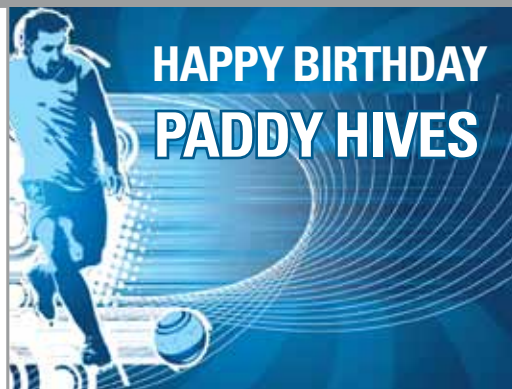

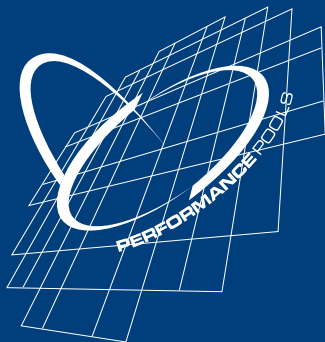
